


BUSINESSES & FACILITIES ALLOWED TO RE-OPEN IN ORANGE COUNTY

The City of Brea continues to work closely with health experts, and State and County officials, to re-open businesses responsibly, safely and at the right time. Business owners and residents are encouraged to comply with all health orders currently in place to reduce the spread of COVID-19.

Governor Newsom released new guidelines for barbershops and hair salons to be able to operate outdoors in a safe environment. All the previously announced closures of indoor operations statewide and in counties that have been on their monitoring list for three consecutive days remain in effect. 

Businesses/Facilities that Can Open with Modifications

- Bars, Breweries, Pubs offering sit-down, dine-in meals – OUTDOORS ONLY
- Campgrounds, RV Parks, and Outdoor Recreation
- Car Washes
- Day Camps
- Esthetician, Skin Care, Cosmetology Services – OUTDOORS ONLY
- Family Entertainment Centers – OUTDOORS ONLY
- Fitness Facilities – OUTDOORS ONLY
- Hair Salons & Barber Shops – OUTDOORS ONLY
- Hotels
- Landscaping Gardening
- Manufacturing
- Massage Services – OUTDOORS ONLY
- Movie Theaters – OUTDOORS ONLY
- Music, television, and film production

- Offices (when telework not possible) – OUTDOORS ONLY FOR NON-ESSENTIAL
- Outdoor Museums
- Personal Care Services (Nail Salons, Body Waxing) – OUTDOORS ONLY
- Pet Groomers
- Places of Worship – OUTDOORS ONLY
- Professional sports without live audiences
- Restaurants* – OUTDOORS & TAKEOUT ONLY
- Retail Shopping, with social distancing
- Satellite Wagering Facilities and Racetracks
- Schools and School-Based Programs – THROUGH DISTANCE LEARNING
- Shopping Malls – OUTDOORS ONLY
- Tanning Facilities
- Tribal Casinos
- Wineries, Tasting Rooms – OUTDOORS ONLY
- Zoos – OUTDOORS ONLY

*Restaurant complaints are handled by the County of Orange. Please call, 714-433-6000.

Before re-opening, businesses/facilities must perform the following modifications:

1. Perform a detailed risk assessment and implement a site-specific protection plan
2. Train employees on how to limit the spread of COVID-19, including how to screen themselves for symptoms and stay home if they have them
3. Implement individual control measures and screenings
4. Implement disinfecting protocols
5. Implement physical distancing guidelines
